Encourage Each Other

In this time of uncertainty, confusion, and downright despair sometimes, it is important to intentionally work at encouraging each other. To facilitate this, I would like to share some Bible verses focusing on encouragement.

In Paul's letter to the people at Colossae, he shared how he hoped to encourage them through his letters and sharing how Jesus Christ makes every believer complete in Him. This passage is from Colossians 2:1-10:

"For I want you to know what a great conflict I have for you and those in Laodicea, and *for* as many as have not seen my face in the flesh, ² that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and *attaining* to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ, ³ in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.⁴ Now this I say lest anyone should deceive you with persuasive words. ⁵ For though I am absent in the flesh, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your *good* order and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ. ⁶ As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, ⁷ rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving. ⁸ Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ. ⁹ For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; ¹⁰ and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power."

David shares his feelings regarding God's presence and help in Psalm 145. This section is taken from verses 3-7:

Great *is* the LORD, and greatly to be praised; And His greatness *is* unsearchable. One generation shall praise Your works to another, And shall declare Your mighty acts.
⁵ I will meditate on the glorious splendor of Your majesty, And on Your wondrous works.⁶ *Men* shall speak of the might of Your awesome acts, And I will declare Your greatness.
⁷ They shall utter the memory of Your great goodness, And shall sing of Your righteousness. The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy.

Another verse that always encourages me is found in Zephaniah 3:17 and reminds us that "The Lord your God in your midst, the Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love. He will rejoice over you with singing." Be encouraged by these words!!
