Dealing With Loss

Don't let anyone ever tell you, "It gets easier with time." Time does not "heal all wounds." It never has, and it never will. Only God can heal. And He does indeed heal. However, even with God's healing, He may sometimes choose to leave scars. This is never meant to be cruel, but to serve a valuable purpose. That purpose can vary for each person, but I will explain only a few. For your personal situation, I urge you to seek God for His clarification.

God desires humility. Scars can produce humility in us as we are reminded that not everything has been "right" in our lives and we were (are still) in need of Him. When we initially experienced the loss of a loved one, our own lives crashed. People may have issued sympathy, but sympathy lasts only a season. Then we found loneliness. A loneliness never felt before. Even with God in our lives, that loved one is no longer.

God grants us empathy. He feels WITH us, and true to His Word, He will never leave us. Why? Because He knows that in this world, the pain will return. That is why Paul could say to us (in the Bible), that we sorrow not as those without hope. We have hope (Jesus Christ). But the point here is Paul saying we also do have sorrow. So, grieve, my friend. Cry, out loud. Let your tears be seen. Don't be ashamed. But cling to the hope you have in Jesus!

God also desires us to learn! God did not just want to give us free salvation through the death of Jesus on the cross & then His resurrection. He wants us to develop a relationship with Himself. Scars can remind us that just as we needed Him to heal us, we need Him to help us continue day after day after day after day. There may have been others involved in the wounding. We need to understand their part. We may need to forgive. We may need to apologize. We may need to take action. We may need to "let go." We do need to seek God. He will reveal His will to us, if we simply seek Him with our whole heart.

My friend, this is what lies at the very depths of my soul. This is what I wake with in the morning and lie down with at night. This is what pumps through my blood. My love for God's people. My desire is that we might all be saved and know God. Please take what I have written with prayer in mind. May God speak to your heart. Hear ye Him.
