## Summer Options

Below are some options for things to do in the Black Hills and surrounding area for the summer. Only a few are listed for each category to make it more user friendly. Enjoy and have a great summer!!

**Rodeos:** June 30-July 4, 2017 Black Hills Roundup in Belle Fourche, SD. Along with the usual rodeo competitions, Cowboy Kenny Bartram and the Steel Rodeo Tour will also be featured during the Roundup. Tickets range from \$16.00 per adult for the Ranch Rodeo, to \$26.00 per adult for reserved seating.

Mt. Rushmore Rodeo at Palmer Gulch KOA located west of Mt. Rushmore on Hiway 244. Dates for these rodeos are: June 10th and 25th, July 30th, August 19th and September 3rd. Cost is \$10.00 for day use customers, free for resort users. Time is 6:30-8:00pm.

**Main Street Square, Rapid City:** Concert Series on Thursdays beginning June 1, 2017 through August 31st from 6-9PM. First concert is Marshall Star. Movies Under the Stars on Mondays beginning June 4, 2017 and runs through August 21 starting at dusk. The first movie is "Jungle Book"! The Cruiser Car Show and Street Fair is Sunday, July 9th from 10AM through 3PM.

**Hiking:** The Centennial Trail # 89 is a 105 –111 mile rugged hiking trail that goes from Bear Butte north of Fort Meade to Wind Cave National Park. The Mickelson Trail, which goes from Deadwood to Edgemont, includes 109 miles of an old railroad bed and is another place to hike or even bike. # Prayer Helps

When Kris Swaitacho was here, she not only met with SNA as a whole, she also met with leadership the evening before. She shared many insights and knowledge she had learned over the years as a single adult ministry leader. Several things really struck me so I thought I would share these things with you to encourage you and build you up.

The first subject that Kris brought to our attention was the need to remember our “WHY”. She asked us why we were involved in SNA and what we felt SNA should be providing. We discussed how singles make up the majority of adults these days in the United States yet many of them feel left out or even ostracized in churches. Our mission, if you will, is to provide a safe place for these singles to grow in their relationship with Jesus and with each other. And if they do not have a relationship with Jesus, we need to be sure we share with them on a regular basis what that entails. We also need to help these singles to become the healthy people God intended them to be with the help of Jesus and each other.

This leads me to the second subject of discussion that encouraged me. This is the issue of prayer. She shared how her ministry is bathed in prayer on a daily basis. We need to be aware of the power of prayer and we need to pray for leadership, upcoming events, needs and each other on a regular basis. This doesn't mean little short “God Bless the food” prayers. This means from the heart “Lord Jesus, guide and direct us and help us do each event from Your point of view, totally surrendered to You,” prayers. As leadership, we do pray over our plans and even try to pray before each event but this challenged me to be in prayer more throughout the weeks leading up to the event and even after it. God is our Strength, our Help and we need to rely on Him more... at least I do.

Another issue that Kris brought up with the entire group is praying for healthy singles, both men and women, and for a mate. We try to keep SNA from looking like a “Dating Service” and sometimes, in my opinion, we go too far the other way and don't bring our concerns and wishes to the group. We sometimes will share with our friends but having each other in a group like SNA pray specifically for our “health” and a mate seems like a good thing, to me. I liked what Kris had us do during the SNA event when she instructed us to get into groups of four, share our concerns and wishes with each other and pray for each other in a personal way. I know not everyone is comfortable with that, and we wouldn't need to do it all the time, but once in awhile could be really beneficial, I believe. In conclusion, I would like to share one of my favorite prayers from the Bible found in Ephesians 3:14-21: <sup>14</sup>For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>15</sup>from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, <sup>16</sup>that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, <sup>17</sup>that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <sup>18</sup>may be able to comprehend with all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height— <sup>19</sup>to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.” Prayer helps!!
