Announcing: New Bible Study Series: Encouragement in the Psalms

For those who were able to attend the potluck and Bible Study/Discussion on April 9th with Orin Covington you may remember the great study and discussion he led on “Faith Over Fear”. His use of Scripture and discussion questions were greatly appreciated and most everyone seemed to be blessed by his sharing. He also shared how he had published a book entitled “Encouraging Words from the Psalms”. Orin has graciously agreed to lead a three part series referencing his book and offering encouragement through the Psalms. He will be leading each of the Bible Study/Discussions during the summer. It will be formatted similar to his presentation on April 9th. He will use some of the information available in his book which will be very encouraging.

To give you more information on his background his book cover describes Orin as “a navy veteran and a Department of the Navy retiree. He took time off from his work with the navy to attend Puget Sound Christian College and earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Bible and Preaching. Orin has pastored churches in Washington, Montana and South Dakota. Orin enjoys fishing and spoiling grandchildren.”

Orin’s book is designed to point out the relevance of the Psalms for today and how God loves them and how He will help them through their issues and struggles. The Psalms contains verses that identify who God is and who we are to Him.

And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross. He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

I Thessalonians 4:16-18

For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. Therefore encourage one another with these words.
