
Introducing our Bible Study Leaders

Lessons from a Cow

My dad, who is a cattle rancher and has raised cattle for more than 60 years, is now 89 years old and has cut his herd down to three cows, one bull and two heifers. He went from raising Herefords, to Charolais, to mixed, to miniature cows (not tiny but smaller than normal). Recently one of his miniature heifers started having contractions about a month and a half early which meant she definitely was not ready to have that calf. She was struggling with the contractions, slowly losing strength and my dad wasn't sure what to do or if he could do what was needed. At 89 years of age, he didn't have the strength he once did to pull the calf although he was able to turn the calf so it wasn't breach. He spent one whole day looking for help. He tried every veterinarian he could talk to trying to get someone to come and assist him with the cow but no one was available. Our neighbor did come over and pray over the cow and calf stating, "God surely does care about the things we care about!" The cow did relax a bit but was still having some contractions. Finally, after much prayer, it was suggested he call a rancher that attends our church to see if he could help. Brian was more than willing to do what he could and showed up with his calf-pullers, his medicines, his arm long gloves... he had it all. Previously, Dad had filled in for our pastor who was on vacation and had preached a sermon about how loving Jesus, really loving Him, causes us to go above and beyond what is "required" to show that love to Jesus. This is the same with any relationship, to show our love we go above and beyond what is expected. And to strengthen a friendship, Dad shared, or even make friends, you can let them do something for you. When Brian had worked and worked with the cow and finally pulled the calf and cleaned out the cow as best he could, and the cow seemed to be doing much better, Dad thanked him profusely and asked him how much he owed him. Brian just looked at him with a smile on his face and said, "Nothing! Just consider us friends!"
