Operation Christmas Child

Samaritan's Purse, an organization whose president is Franklin Graham, provides goods and services for needy people around the world. They have a special event in November that provides Christmas presents to children all

over the world. We at SNA want to get involved in providing presents for these children. We would love to have your help. This is the plan:

On Saturday, November 12th, we will be meeting at Christian Life Ministries for a potluck meal and to put together shoeboxes to send to Operation Christmas Child. **What you can do is bring as many items as you can from the following list:**

Pens, pencils, sharpeners, crayons, markers, stamps, ink pad sets, writing pads, paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, small Etch-A-Sketch, toys that light up or make noise (with extra batteries), Slinky, toothbrush, toothpaste, mild bar soap (in a plastic bag), comb, washcloth, t-shirts, socks, ball caps, sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries), shoeboxes to put items in, and money to help send the shoeboxes.

Please DO NOT bring used or damaged items, war-related items, chocolate or food, out-or-date candy, liquids or lotions, medications or vitamins, breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers, or aerosol cans.

Every shoebox we pack needs a check for \$7.00 to help cover shipping and other project costs. If you would like to donate money, that would be great, too. We will, also, be putting on a label that designates whether the gift is for a boy or a girl and the age category: 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14.

Along with the gifts in the shoebox, each box includes a booklet called, "The Greatest Gift of All". This tells the children about Jesus and His love and His wonderful gift of salvation.

Some of the countries where Operation Christmas Child has helped are Uganda, Philippines, and Panama. Operation Christmas Child's mission is " to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way to needy children around the world, and together with the local church worldwide, to share the Good News of Jesus Christ."

Following is a brief blurb about the history of Samaritan's Purse: Through over 30 years of earthquakes, hurricanes, wars, and famine, Franklin has led the ministry in following the Biblical example of the Good Samaritan all across the globe. "Go and do likewise," Christ commanded after explaining the parable of the Good Samaritan in Luke 10. So they do. Samaritan's Purse travels the world's highways looking for victims along the way. They are quick to bandage the wounds, but like the Samaritan, they don't stop there. In addition to meeting I immediate, emergency needs, they help these victims recover and get back on their feet. No matter where they go or what they do, they offer to suffering people in a broken world, the news of the only One who can bring true peace—Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace.
